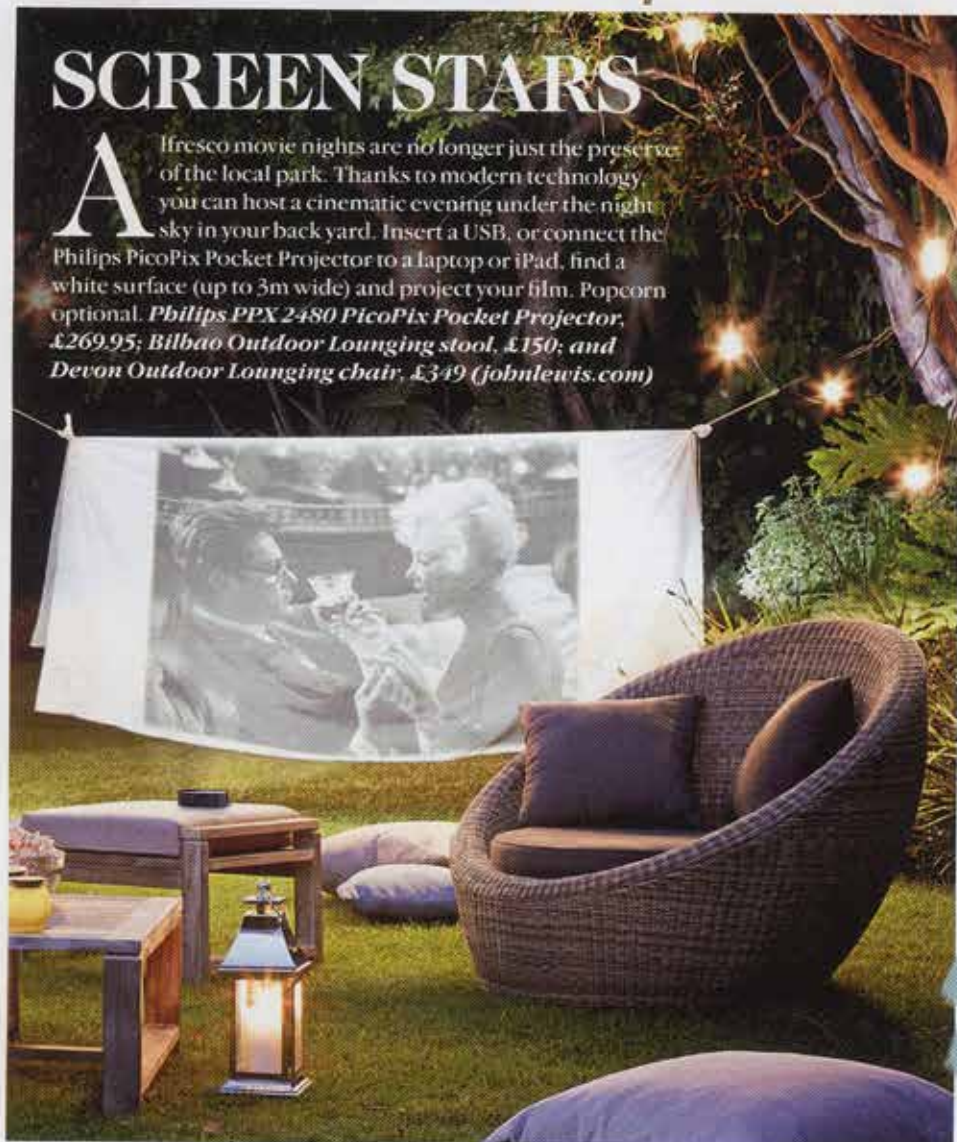


BE DAZZLED
