1. SHINING LIGHT

Michael S. Smith's *Southampton* mirror has a glittering, faceted frame—super-stylish, but not an iota overwrought; \$2,848, mirrorimagehome.com.

4. PERFECT PEDESTAL

Warm metal elements balance the sleek white lacquered *Yacht* table, a sophisticated breakfast-room staple; \$17,250, soane.com.

5. FLAIR FOR DRAMA

With curving plaster-like fronds, the *Camilla* table lamp mines a French 1930s moment to great, glamorous effect; \$380, curreycodealers.com.

6. BRING ON THE CHARM

The ceramist Frances Palmer's *Dahlia* box is a playful objet for the vanity, inspired by the work of Dagobert Peche; \$400, neuegalerie.com.

7. MASTERFUL REISSUE

Pique-Nique, a variegated stripe printed on linen, first appeared in 1965 and was a favorite of Billy Baldwin's; to the trade, brunschwig.com.

8. HANDY HARDWARE

A palm-shape door handle based on a 19th-century original will add a just-right dose of whimsy to a dressing room; \$828 a pair, charlesedwards.com.

9. SIMPLE ELEGANCE
